<u>4. Public Question Time</u>: There were seven members of the public present. Mr Phil Bowley from GreenSquare gave an update on the situation at Rudloe. Ideas could then be discussed and the process could be started

He was asked why other areas at Rudloe had not been asked to join the Steering Group. It was replied that the Parish Council has three representatives. It was hoped to have a mix of people.

Mr Elliot reported that there is a small tree fallen onto the path at Leafy Lane. He also stated that the 50 mph speed limit on the A4 is in the wrong place. The Chairman replied that the signs are in the statutory positions.

Mr Elliot asked whether a "Caution 30 mph – Slow down now" sign as displayed in B&NES could be put onto the A4.

Mr Kalidoski raised issues regarding S106/CIL monies. He would send a copy to the Clerk.

**Parish Council boundary signs**: Two quotations had been received for the erection of the signs in the sums of £1920 and £2036.04. After discussion it was unanimously agreed to accept the quotation from Ringway in the sum of £2036.04. The signs will be ordered.

Neighbourhood Plan: Cllrs Cox and Parker had attended a meeting with Wiltshire Council.

Cllrs Botterill, Cox and Parker will be attending a Local Plan Review meeting on 8<sup>th</sup> July

<u>**Rural Housing Needs Survey**</u>; The draft report had been received from Wiltshire Council, circulated to all Councillors and was agreed.

**The Blind House**: Cllr Cox gave a report on a meeting held with Caroline Ridgwell, the Listed Buildings Officer to discuss the repairs to the Blind House.

**<u>13.</u>** Box Hill Common & Rudloe Management/Rights of Way Committee;</u> The Minutes of the Meeting held on 17<sup>th</sup> June 2019 were submitted.

**Painting of Rudioe Play Area**: Two quotations had been received in the sum of £3044 and £2000. It was agreed to accept the quotation for £2000 from Christopher James Painting and Decorating. Clerk to ask Wiltshire Council for advice re the type of paint. It was agreed that the area would have to be closed whilst the work was being carried out and that this should be done outside the school holidays.

## 14. Highway Issues:

Cllr Hill gave a report on the recent CATG meeting:

- <u>Kingsdown</u> Road: A Petition had been lodged with Wiltshire council for a 40mph speed limit on the main Kingsdown Road. The Parish Council were asked to support a Speed Limit Assessment which would cost £2500 with the Parish Council contributing 25% It was proposed and agreed that a metro count would be requested first
- <u>A4 by Moon HouseA4 by Moon House</u>: Request for a speed reduction submitted by a resident. After discussion the Parish Council did not support this
- <u>Prospect</u>: The results of the metro count were as follows: The 85<sup>th</sup> percentile speed was 26.1 mph and the mean speed was 21.1 mph. 2.6% of recorded vehicles were exceeding the posted speed limit the mean speed of these vehicles was 32.08 mph. No further action.

### 15. To receive any urgent correspondence:

- a. <u>Use of Football Pitch</u>; It was agreed Spartax Rudloe could take over the use of the football pitch from Box Rovers
- b. <u>**Campfest request for water bowser**</u>; Permission for a water bowser at the Campfest to reduce water/plastic waste was given
- c. <u>Best Kept Village Competition</u>: The results had been received. Box had been placed second.
- **d**. <u>**Cemetery Lodge**</u>: Notice received that the tenants will be vacating at the end of July. It was agreed to ask the agents to look for new tenants and to increase the rental to £800 per month.
- e. <u>MoD Liaison Meeting</u>; To be held in the Town Hall, Corsham on Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> July at 7 pm Cllrs Campbell and Hill to attend.
- f. <u>Queens Square, footpaths and trees</u>: letter from Brian Mathew confirming that he is in contact with GreenSquare re the state of the pavements, trees etc.
- **g**. <u>Network Rail</u>: Letter from Network Rail notifying that the safety critical vegetation management team would be carrying out work on the railway between Box and Shockerwick between 15<sup>th</sup> July and 27<sup>th</sup> September. The Clerk had asked if work to Footpath 2 could also be included in the programme. It was agreed to ask if the vegetation growing out of Box Tunnel, including an Ash tree could be cleared.
