- c. <u>Blind House/Bus shelters/Fountain/Pound/Viewing Platform:</u> <u>Blind House</u>: Regular checks to be carried out <u>Fountain</u>: A quotations for restoring the lettering on the plaque on the back wall of the Fountain was obtained in March 2018 but it was decided not to pursue this as this is almost the same wording as the plaque on the Fountain itself. It was agreed to check the wording on the Fountain again.

**Viewing Platform**: Regular checks on the condition of the Viewing Platform to be carried out

It was agreed that the Committee would carry out a check on the Blind House, Fountain, Pound and Viewing Platform at a meeting in the Spring Action; Committee

New bedroom proposed in the roof space No objections 19/00390/FUL 5 Mead Villas, High Street, Box Three storey side extension Objections. This is an overlarge development which will completely change the street scene and closes up the openness of the countryside. We would ask whether this exceedsthe 30% allowance for Green Belt 19/00760/TCA Ashley Farmhouse, Ashley Work to trees in a Conservation Area No objections 19/00761/FUL 22 Fairmead View, Mill Lane Carport to match adjoining neighbours No objections 19/00863/FUL 4 Lower Kingsdown Road, Box Relocation of garage and revise drive, replace, reduce height of roof, create new extension and rebuild rear terrace Objections. This is overdevelopment of the site 19/01173/TCA Linguarama, Cheney Court, Ditteridge 17 Lime trees – pollard to maintain size and shape No objections but would comment that the trees need tiding up
