19/05162/FUL Brookside, The Bassetts, Box

Demolition of existing garage and construction of new double

garage

No objections in principle but the Parish Council feels that the wood cladding is out of keeping with the street scene and would prefer the

use of stone

19/05171/FUL 2 Hazelbury Hill, Box

Creation of car parking area – previously unused grass bank

Objections. The Parish Council feels that this will cause an obstruction and congestion in a one way road which could cause obstruction to emergency vehicles as cars park on the road

opposite

The Parish Council queries whether the land belongs to the applicant and asks whether Wiltshire Highways have been

consulted.
