4. Public Question Time: There were two members of the public present.

Laura Williams and Philip Squire from Savills gave a presentation on the proposed new Data Centre at Spring Park. Permission had previously been granted for offices but these are not needed and will be replaced with a further data centre.

- **<u>6.</u> <u>Minutes</u>**: The Minutes of the meeting held on 11<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup> November 2019 were taken as read and signed as being a true record
- 7. Matters Arising:
  - a. Enforcement matters: Updates were given and two further issues raised
  - **b.** <u>Notice Boards</u>: Continue to monitor the condition of all notice boards
  - c. <u>Blind House/Fountain</u>: Quotation received from Marcus Mitchell for the repair work to the stone work and removal of vegetation in the sum of £380. The Listed Buildings Officer had visited the site and repairs are required to the internal toilet lid. The bed appeared to be drying out satisfactorily. An application to be made to English Heritage for the work. The Listed Buildings Officer had commented about the sign erected on the wall adjacent to the Blind House

**<u>Viewing Platform</u>**: Regular checks on the condition of the Viewing Platform to be carried out

- d. <u>Risk Assessment:</u> To be reviewed again shortly
- e. <u>Bus shelters:</u> Continue to monitor the condition. Provision had been made in the budget for the repainting of the bus shelters. It was reported that there had been further vandalism to the bus shelter by the Rising Sun site. It was suggested that in the circumstancs the collage should not be pursued at the present time. Clerk to pursue anti graffiti treatment
- e. <u>Settlement boundary review</u>: Waiting the outcome of the consultation
- f. <u>Neighbourhood Plan</u>: Waiting reply from Georgina Clampett Dix regarding an explanation for the new housing figures for Box. Next meeting to be held 6<sup>th</sup> January
- **g.** <u>Late publication of Planning Notices</u>; Letter received from Simon Smith explaining the procedure re the publication of planning notices. The Committee did not feel that this explanation was satisfactory and this will be raised with the County Councillors and to the Cabinet member for Planning.

h. <u>Provision of a community shop at Rudloe</u>: Bellway Homes had replied stating that the employments units at the bottom of the site are owned by Bath ASU and they would not be able to dedicate any space to a retain unit. Waiting for a reply from the developers for the Rudloe No 2 site.

Cllr Davies stated that the Parish Council should have raised the provision of a shop when the amended plan had been submitted
